#### P6 Special Assembly

#### Free School Meals

If your child receives Free School Meals, **please remember** you still need to order their school meal through Pay360 every week.

#### **Attendance**

If your child is off school due to sickness or any other reason please phone the School Office to inform us on the first day of their absence. This <u>MUST</u> be followed up with a letter explaining their absence on the day they return to school.

#### **Pay 360**

Pay360 will continue to be used for dinner payments. We will also use this system for swimming, some clubs and various other things throughout the year.

Please pay during the designated time for the week ahead, this week, (Friday 1pm - Monday 9.00 am). If any parents are still having issues with the Pay360 please call to the School Office.

#### Car Parking

We would appreciate it if parents did not park at the school gates during drop off and pick up times. The Chapel Car Park is opened especially for the parents to use and the safety of all the children is our priority.

# Swimming Lessons

P6 pupils have begun swimming lessons every Thursday, this should be paid through Pay360. Parents will be able to pay weekly (£4 per week). Pay 360 will open on Friday 23rd September 2022 at 9am and will close on Thursday 29th September at 9am this week.

# Breakfast club

Breakfast Club is available every morning and will be on a <u>pay as you go basis</u>. The cost is £2 per day and the club will run from 8am - 8.50am. You can pay your weekly breakfast club payment at the beginning of the week however you <u>must</u> sign your child in as you drop them off each day. **Cash payments only for breakfast club.** 

#### Drop off and collection times

Classroom doors will be open between 8:50am and 9:00am each morning. Children should not be on school premises prior to this unless they are attending breakfast club. Late arrivals after these times should come through the main front door.

#### Parent teacher meetings

Details regarding the pastoral phone calls on the 10th and 11th October will follow next week.

#### **Nut Allergies**

We have several children in school who suffer from nut and other allergies. It is important that there is strict avoidance to this food group in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Consequently, we must ask that you do not send nuts or nut products into school (either for healthy break or packed lunch). This includes peanut paste, Nutella, all nuts and cooking oil containing peanut oil, as well as foods containing nuts such as cereals and muesli bars. This is particularly relevant now that children are eating lunches in their classrooms. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

#### **Allergies**

If your child has an Allergy Action Plan, please ensure that the school are aware of this and medication is kept updated. This is the responsibility of every parent.
