Flu Immunisation Programme

Halloween Break

School closes at 11am on Friday 28th October after the Halloween Parade at 10.30am in the playground (weather permitting).

Pupils must be collected from their classroom door after the parade and **not** leave from the playground.

Staff Car Park

The Staff Car Park at the front of the school should **not** be used for drop off or pick up of pupils at school finishing times. The Chapel Car Park is opened for parents to use and the safety of our pupils is our priority. Thank you for your cooperation.

Signatures Required

If during your Parent/Teacher Telephone Call you were asked to call to the School Office to sign documents, it is important that you call in as soon as possible. Reminder letters have been sent home with pupils as well.

Attendance

If your child is off school due to sickness or any other reason, please phone the School Office to inform us on the first day of their absence. Our attendance records are legal documents and so any absence must be followed up with a letter giving a reason for the absence on the day the pupil returns to school.

UEFA Disney Playmakers Programme

The Irish Football Association curriculum sports programme for Primary 3 and Primary 4 pupils, this will continue on Wednesday 26th October. P3 and P4 pupils should wear PE gear on Wednesdays.

Please wear appropriate bottoms and bring trainers in a bag.

School Business

We are always keen to keep a record of anyone who may be available to fill positions within the school (either short or longer term). This would include classroom assistants, cleaners and lunchtime supervisors. Please send a CV into the school office.

P6 Swimming Lessons

P6 pupils swimming lessons continue every Thursday, this should be paid through Pay360. Parents can pay weekly (£4 per week). Pay 360 will open on Friday 21st October 2022 at 9am and will close on Thursday 27th October at 9am this week. If your child misses Swimming this week due to the Sustrans Programme a refund will be issued on Pay360.

Breakfast club

Breakfast Club is available every morning and is on a pay as you go basis. The cost is £2 per day and runs from 8am — 8:50am. You can pay your weekly breakfast club payment at the beginning of the week however you must sign your child in as you drop them off each day.

Note: Friday 28th October — Only Toast/Pancakes and Water/Juice available — no cereals.

Parent/Grandparent Helpers

We require parent/grandparent helpers to accompany our classes on school trips this year.

We have a busy schedule of trips and activities planned for the year and we depend on these volunteers to enable us to take the children on these events.

We would really appreciate your help.

Nut Allergies

We have several children in school who suffer from nut and other allergies. It is important that there is strict avoidance to this food group in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Consequently, we must ask that you do not send nuts or nut products into school (either for healthy break or packed lunch). This includes peanut paste, Nutella, all nuts and cooking oil containing peanut oil, as well as foods containing nuts such as cereals and muesli bars. This is particularly relevant now that children are eating lunches in their classrooms. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Pay 360 and Free School Meals

Pay 360 will continue to be used for dinner payments. We will also use this system for swimming, some clubs and various other things throughout the year.

Please pay during the designated time for the week ahead, this week (Friday 1pm — Monday 9.00am).

If any parents are still having issues with the Pay360 please call to the School Office.

If your child receives Free School Meals, **<u>please remember</u>** you still need to order their school meal through Pay360 every week.

Monday Morning Mass at 10am


I have a concern about my child/a child's safety
