Just a reminder that Larne Foodbank can help by providing food parcels to support to families during the October half-term holidays.




Change of Date for the Flu Immunisation Programme

Attendance

School Business

Swimming Lessons

P6 pupils swimming lessons continue every Thursday, this should be paid through Pay360. Parents can pay weekly (£4 per week). Pay 360 will open on Friday 14th October 2022 at 9am and will close on Thursday 20th October at 9am this week.

Breakfast club

Breakfast Club is available every morning and will be on a <u>pay as you go basis</u>. The cost is £2 per day and the club will run from 8am — 8:50am. You can pay your weekly breakfast club payment at the beginning of the week however you <u>must</u> sign your child in as you drop them off each day.

Parent/Grandparent Helpers

We require parent/grandparent helpers to accompany our classes on school trips this year.

We have a busy schedule of trips and activities planned for the year and we depend on these volunteers to enable us to take the children on these events.

If you would like your name added to our volunteer list (following Access NI Clearing Check) please contact the School Office. We would really appreciate your help.

Nut Allergies

We have several children in school who suffer from nut and other allergies. It is important that there is strict avoidance to this food group in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Consequently, we must ask that you do not send nuts or nut products into school (either for healthy break or packed lunch). This includes peanut paste, Nutella, all nuts and cooking oil containing peanut oil, as well as foods containing nuts such as cereals and muesli bars. This is particularly relevant now that children are eating lunches in their classrooms. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Pay 360 and Free School Meals

Pay360 will continue to be used for dinner payments. We will also use this system for swimming, some clubs and various other things throughout the year.

Please pay during the designated time for the week ahead, this week (Friday 1pm - Monday 9.00am).

If any parents are still having issues with the Pay360 please call to the School Office.

If your child receives Free School Meals, **please remember** you still need to order their school meal through Pay360 every week.

Monday Morning Mass at 10am

The Primary 5 pupils will attend Monday morning Mass on Monday 17th October 2022. The Primary 4 pupils will attend Monday morning Mass on Monday 24th October 2022.
