# P6 Swimming Lessons

Primary 6 pupils swimming lessons will continue on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2022 this should be paid through Pay360. Parents can pay weekly (£4 per week). Pay 360 will open on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> December at 9am and will close on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December at 9am for the next session.

#### Breakfast club

Breakfast Club is available every morning and is on a <u>pay as you go basis</u>. The cost is £2 per day and runs from 8am — 8:50am. You can pay your weekly breakfast club payment at the beginning of the week however you <u>must</u> sign your child in as you drop them off each day.

#### Pay 360 and Free School Meals

Pay360 will continue to be used for dinner payments. We will also use this system for swimming, some clubs and various other things throughout the year.

Please pay during the designated time for the week ahead, this week (Friday 1pm - Monday 9.00am).

If any parents are still having issues with the Pay360 please call to the School Office.

If your child receives Free School Meals, <u>please remember</u> you still need to order their school meal through Pay360 every week.

#### Attendance

If your child is off school due to sickness or any other reason, please phone the School Office to inform us on the first day of their absence. Our attendance records are legal documents and so any absence must be followed up with a letter giving a reason for the absence on the day the pupil returns to school





# Children's Christmas Shopping Event

As our PTA Christmas shopping event gets closer there are a few things to note. Children can buy up to **two** gifts initially (these are all new, unused items). The gifts range in price from £1 to £5 and will be clearly laid out so the children can see how much each item costs. It is up to you how much money you want to send in with your child — we recommend anything between £2 and £15 (£15 will be the maximum that they could spend if buying three £5 gifts). There will be a chance to purchase more than two items later on in the day.



### **Nut Allergies**

We have several children in school who suffer from nut and other allergies. It is important that there is strict avoidance to this food group in order to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Consequently, we must ask that you do not send nuts or nut products into school (either for healthy break or packed lunch). This includes peanut paste, Nutella, all nuts and cooking oil containing peanut oil, as well as foods containing nuts such as cereals and muesli bars. This is particularly relevant now that children are eating lunches in their classrooms. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.
